Pastor Jeff Evans, President and CEO of Minnesota Family Council, will be a special guest speaker for the Biblical Citizenship Class at Bunde CRC on Sunday, October 13 at 3 pm. Jeff grew up in Michigan and has been a pastor for nearly 20 years. In 2019, he stepped down as head pastor of his church to launch the Church Ambassador Network, which is an initiative of Minnesota Family Council for pastors to minister to elected officials in St. Paul. In January of this year, he became the President & CEO of Minnesota Family Council. He and his wife, Chrissy, have five children, ages 23 down to 6. Please join others from our community to learn how Minnesota Family Counsel is advancing foundational biblical principles in churches, the media, government, and the public square throughout the state of Minnesota. You will get an understanding how they are mobilizing Christians to transform Minnesota’s culture so that it cherishes life, affirms religious liberty, and preserves marriage and the family. A video from the Liberty Initiative and refreshments will follow Pastor Evans’ talk. Even if you have not attended a Biblical citizenship class, we are inviting you to come at 3:00 to listen to Jeff share about the work he is doing. You won’t want to miss this.
